



## Advanced course part 1

### Clinical management of Craniomandibular and Craniofacial dysfunctions and pain

#### Course objectives

- Addition and enhancement of bio-medical and practical knowledge of the basic courses;
- In - depth exploration of different clinical patterns in the craniofacial region such as craniomandibular motor dyscontrol , rehabilitation of chewing, pain and dysfunction of the orbital region and neuromuscular dysfunction in infants
- Practical knowledge about photography and clinimetrics specified for the craniofacial region
- Introduction to craniofacial pain management and application of some pain management strategies
- Application of acquired knowledge for the diagnosis and treatment of patients including patient presentations with 2 "follow ups"
- In - depth exploration of clinical reasoning strategies specifically focused on the craniomandibular and craniofacial region by means of lectures, case histories and treatment of patients
